Neurodiversity Awareness Understanding the concepts of neurodiversity and disability, and build participants awareness in the workplace. Participants will develop an understanding of the importance of fostering an inclusive and supportive environment for all employees, regardless of their neurodivergence. By the end of this training, participants will appreciate how neurodivergence can improve team dynamics and enhance overall performance.
